Annual Report of the College Students Union 2023–24 Bethania Institute of Management Studies, Kunnamkulam

Introduction

The College Students Union of Bethania Institute of Management Studies (BIMS) is a vital democratic body that fosters leadership, collaboration, and cultural engagement among students. Elected annually, the Union comprises key positions such as the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Joint Secretary, General Captain, Fine Arts Secretary, Student Editor, and University Union Councillor. These members work under the guidance of staff advisors appointed by the principal to ensure the smooth functioning of the Union and to promote the holistic development of students.

The Union's activities are designed to provide students with opportunities to explore their interests, develop leadership skills, and contribute to the college community. Through a variety of events, competitions, and initiatives, the Union aims to create an inclusive and vibrant campus environment.

Union Election 2023–24

The election process for the 2023–24 College Students Union was conducted with meticulous planning and adherence to democratic principles. The process began on **10th October 2023** with the official notification issued by Returning Officer Mr. Fazil Bappu. The election schedule was published, outlining key dates for nominations, scrutiny, withdrawals, polling, and result declaration.

A total of **29 students** from the BCA, B.Com, and BBA departments were eligible to vote. The election was conducted for eight positions, with two posts—Vice Chairman and Joint Secretary—reserved for Lady candidates. The nomination process saw active participation, with candidates filing their nominations by **17th October 2023**.

Key Election Dates:

- **10th October 2023**: Notification of election and publication of the preliminary electoral roll.
- 12th October 2023: Finalization of the electoral roll after corrections and additions.
- 17th October 2023: Scrutiny of nominations and publication of the list of valid
- **18th October 2023**: Withdrawal of nominations and publication of the final candidate list.
- **1st November 2023**: Polling from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM, followed by counting and declaration of results.

Election Highlights:

- Chairman: John Clint (1st BCA) emerged victorious with 24 out of 27 votes, defeating Gopikrishnan P K (2 votes).
- Secretary: Rahin P S (1st BCA) won with 15 votes, surpassing Joyel E J (8 votes).
- Uncontested Positions: Several candidates were elected unopposed, including Vice Chairperson Neeraja Vijayan K (1st BCA), Joint Secretary Sivanandhana M S (1st B.Com), University Union Councillor Jayasoorya A R (1st BBA), Fine Arts Secretary Bretlee P Babu (1st B.Com), Student Editor Alan P Joby (1st BCA), and General Captain Arnold Stallone M Salamon (1st BCA).

The oath-taking ceremony was held on **11th December 2023** during the Union Inauguration. The event was graced by Malayalam film director Lenin (of *Article 21* fame) and his partner, Praseena. Elected members pledged to uphold democratic values, transparency, and student welfare. The ceremony marked the formal induction of the Union body and set the tone for their tenure.



ACTIVITIES ORGANIZED

Onam Celebration – "ത്രില്പോണം"
